Directions:
 From I-275 exit at Mt. Healthy (US 127) and go North. Turn Left on W. Kemper. Follow W. Kemper across Pippin, past Germania Park (on the left) to Lick Rd (on the right). Turn right on Lick Rd. Follow Lick Rd up the hill. Walnut Creek Stables will be at the top of the hill –12080. Follow the signs to parking areas. The Dressage phase will be held in an indoor or outdoor sand arena. Warm up will be held in a sand arena. The jumping phase will be held in the 150x300 sand outdoor arena. Warm up will be in sand outdoor or grass arena. **Limited** stabling is available at the farm. **E mail or text Kristie for stabling** information – contact Kristie at kmlequineservices@gmail.com. Stabling Fee is \$35. Shavings are available. \$8.00/bag; please pre-order.

Entry Fees:
\$65.00 per division or \$110.00 if entered in two divisions (for same/horse rider combination). Dressage only class is \$25.00 per class plus other fees. \$15.00 Office Fee. \$15 late fee if entry received after closing date. If mailed must be postmarked by closing date.

No Refunds after closing date. Entry fee less \$15 administrative fee if withdrawal is received in writing before closing date. Negative Coggins within 12 months and current health certificate (if out-of-state) required with entry.

Start Times:
 Enclose legible **e-mail** address for start time. Ride times will be emailed.

Awards:
 Ribbons through sixth place given in each division.

Safety Gear Requirements:
 Proper headgear, per USEA rules, required. Certified helmets required for jumping and junior riders at all times. Medical Armbands required for jumping. Safety jumping vests are encouraged, but not required.

All Combined Tests Classes will be subject to the current rules and regulations of the USEF. No reading of the tests is permitted for the Combined Test Classes.
